

## CHOCOLATE BOX BOTTOM

*DIY Chocolate Box from Mel's Kitchen Café ([www.melskitchencafe.com](http://www.melskitchencafe.com))*

- Use cardstock for the top of the box (regular paper isn't heavy enough for the chocolate boxes). Cut on the solid lines, fold on the dotted lines.
- I have made the lines light in color so that they won't be overly obvious if you choose to print out each box and fold it separately. Alternately, if you don't want any print lines at all, you can print one template and trace it by hand onto your desired cardstock and eyeball the fold lines.
- If you print each box, make sure to print on the **WRONG** or **UNPATTERNED** side of your cardstock.
